The Franciscan Earth Literacy Center (FELC) is an environmental education center and demonstration facility designed to promote the appreciation of nature and encourages sustainable living practices.

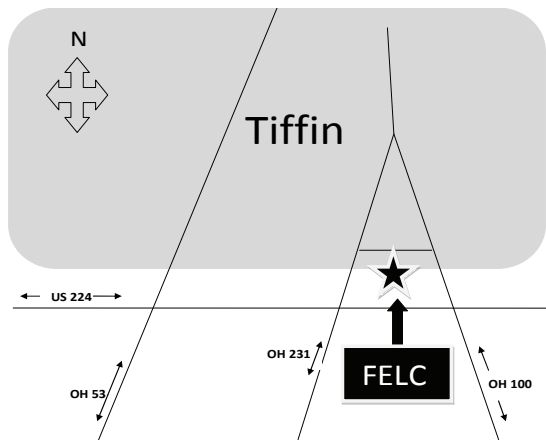

**Facilities**

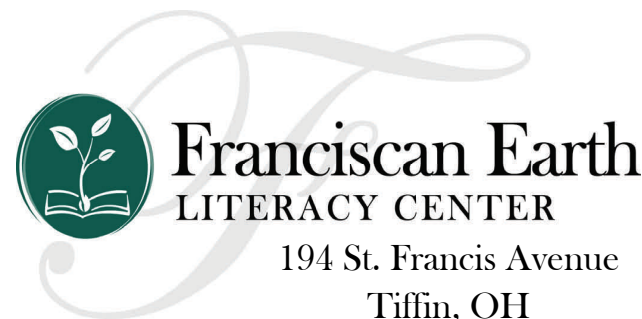
